


The Lector Ministry offers the privilege of proclaiming the Word of God as an essential part of the Liturgy, sharing in a sacred process in the life of the Church. Lectors are dedicated to presenting the Scriptures reverently and sincerely. Training is provided.

LITURGICAL ENVIRONMENT

The liturgical environment reflects the changing of the seasons in the church for Advent, Christmas, Ordinary Time, Lent, Holy Week, Easter and Pentecost when our sacred space is enhanced through colors and accent pieces to convey the story proclaimed in our Scripture readings as we gather to celebrate our Liturgies.

THE PRAYER & REFLECTION GARDEN

We are excited about the installation of our prayer & reflection garden! This is going to be a beautiful space for all to reflect on the blessings God provides.

Phase I of the garden is complete. Over 600 perennials were planted last October and the funds have been raised to add granite benches, Beatitude pavers, a trellis and a bubbling water fountain in the spring. Additionally, parishioners have purchased nearly 400 bricks to place along the border of the winding path.

MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL MUSIC GROUP

CANTORS, INSTRUMENTALISTS AND ACCOMPANISTS

Lend your voice or instrument (piano, organ, flute, trumpet, etc.) skills in leadership to the hymns, songs, and responses of the liturgy. These musicians meet 30 minutes before Mass to rehearse and prepare for the Mass. Musicians should be highly motivated, skilled, and capable of preparing music on their own.

MUSIC MINISTRY VOLUNTEERS

The Music Department at St. Victoria welcomes any volunteers to help organize music files and prepare for special events/concerts. We also need help with setup/teardown and audio for the outdoor Mass.

AGAPE SINGERS

This volunteer choir provides choral music for weekend Masses and on certain Holy Days as well. The choir meets once weekly for an hour rehearsal and provides music at Mass once a month. Rehearsals begin after Labor Day and continue through May.

JUBILATE DEO






LOS AMADOS ("THE BELOVED")
